2. Video must be a minimum of 30 seconds and a maximum of 120 seconds.

4. Submitted videos must include parent/guardian permission information for all video participants. Parent/guardian permission information can be submitted by selecting the box below.
5. Winning videos will be displayed on CEDAR Indiana's Facebook page.
